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LRC44 – Dye Stopper

The Dye Stopper is a liquid designed to give leather a protective coating and stop dirt and grime build up and make removing dye transfer much easier.

This coating is like a ceramic without being a ceramic. Ceramics can cause issues on leather, and they stop the surface breathing and this accelerates the leather drying out and cracking to appear.

The Dye Stopper bonds to the surface but allows the items to breathe fully, giving a clear coating layer that stops dirt, stains and grime bonding and causing damage to the surface. This allows the stain to sit on the coating, allowing an easy wipe away barrier keeping leathers cleaner longer and protecting them better.

First of all, you would need to deep clean your leather to remove all dirt, grime, and residues on the surface and in the grain.

Spray an even coating on and rub onto an application pad and rub into the leather surface in a similar manner to applying ceramic coatings. When applying the coating, if you do spray directly onto the leather spray at distance of between 6 to 9 inches away from the surface, you don't want to flood the leather surfaces, you only need to apply a single coating and its application is almost identical to ceramic coatings.

Do not over apply this product as it can make the leather go shiny and you don't want that to happen, it's a single application process, applied via the sponge as mentioned above.

Pigmented Leather: The dye stopper is a simple spray on, leave to dry and buff up the area afterwards. Do not over apply, a single spray application is enough on pigmented leather finishes.

If you wanted to apply a second coat, you must let the first coat dry, speed this up with a hair dryer and then buff off any excess. Apply the second coating and follow the same steps above. Do not apply more than two coats.

Aniline Leather: On porous leather like aniline, spray apply and leave to dry, then apply a second coat and leave to dry again. No need to buff off any excess on this type of leather, just allow the product to soak in and protect the leather. But for the best protection use the dedicated aniline protection spray

On Fake Leathers: The dye stopper works on all types of fake leathers and application is the same as pigmented leathers, deep clean first and allow to dry, apply a single coating using a pad, dry and then apply a second coating if desired to protect the surface and stop dirt and grime build up.

Temperatures, do not allow to freeze or go below 7 °C.

Before Use, always check in a small hidden area before using to ensure its suitability for the leather.

Colour, opaque cloudy liquid.

Smell, slight aroma, no specific scent.

Drying Time, around 5 minutes depending how thickly applied.

Formula, a liquid protection spray.

Skin Allergies, if you have skin allergies always wear gloves, wear goggles when applying.

Cautions, Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children, may cause skin irritation. Seek medical attention at once, do not induce vomiting. Avoid contact with eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing. Use a mask at all times using in a well-ventilated area.
