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LRC8 Aniline Mousse Cleaner

To clean delicate leathers like aniline, nappa leather, two tone, rub off or antique pigmented leathers you need to use the LRC8 Aniline Mousse Cleaner.

The LRC8 Aniline Mousse Cleaner is a very effective cleaner that deep cleans into the grain removing all dirt and grime. A mousse cleaner is required where leathers are a little delicate like aniline, two tone finishes, antique items, rub off leathers, or fine nappa leathers where you don't want to over wet the surface to be cleaned. This means the mousse cleaner works perfectly on pigmented fashion goods where you don't want to create a stain from cleaning smaller sections.

Pump the LRC8 Aniline Mousse Cleaner onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion. This will lift all the dirt and grime away from the leather as it deep cleans the areas. Then wipe away all dirt and grime with a bamboo fibre towel.

If your leather is extremely dirty, then you can use a Brucler Leather Cleaning Brush to agitate the mousse on the surface to lift away the dirt and grime. Creating a beautiful luxurious finish, finishing off with a bamboo cleaning pad to remove any final dirt and grime.

Predominantly leather that has a sheen to it is generally dirty, the sheen is created due to grease and grime on the leather that becomes shiny, in a lot of cases leather has a semi-matt finish to it, but when it's gone shiny it's the dirt and grime creating the shine, causing further damage to your leather surface.

We have given below a guide to cleaning items such as [Aniline Leathers](#), [Nappa Leather](#) and [Semi Aniline Leather](#).

The first stage of cleaning is to lightly vacuum off your leather item with a soft brush attachment to remove all dirt and debris from the leather, this will avoid scratching the leather when the cleaning process starts. If you are cleaning a handbag or purse, then it's advised that you vacuum out your item from all compartments first of all.



Step 1 Vacuum off the debris – Leather Cleaning

The next stage is to use a microscope if you have one to assess any damage that may be on the leather where you have to proceed with caution.

The bamboo cleaning pads are the safest method to clean aniline leather or veg tanned leathers, but if you have let your leather get too dirty then the bruce brush will have to be used at some stage to get deep down into the grain, then finish off with the bamboo cleaning pad. When using a bruce cleaning brush don't scrub too hard.

Once you have passed this stage you can proceed to use the LRC8 Aniline Mousse Cleaner, this can be pumped directly onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion, lifting all dirt and grime away into the foam. If you don't have a bamboo pad then the Aniline Mousse Cleaner can be pumped directly onto the leather and you can work this into the grain with a [bruce leather cleaning brush](#). But on leather like this you would use the brush gently, don't scrub too hard as the fine grains on anilines and leathers where it has a delicate finish like calf skins, veg tanned leather are easily damaged if you brush too harshly with the brush. You only gently clean the leathers surface, let the cleaner do the work and then gently massage in the solution to lift away the dirt and grime.

Once you have cleaned the area you are working on, lift all dirt away with a [natural bamboo towel](#) or soft terry towel, turning the towel to a clean side as you go. This will help to dry the surface leaving the leather feeling and looking fresh again. Let your items dry naturally NEVER force dry them with heat. Always protect your leather after cleaning.

Uses, to be used on all types of aniline leather, proceed with caution on two tone items, can be used on plastic trim, wont affect fabrics beside leather, also works on fake leathers.

Works on, furniture, handbags, leather jackets, shoes, motorcycle suits, equestrian, purses, car interiors, anilines, vinyl's, pigmented, semi aniline, waxy pull-up, two tone, antique, rub-off, faux, vegan, bonded and by cast leathers.
