LRC20 – Leather Softening Crème

The leather softening crème is a special creation of chemicals to make a product designed to soften leather that's pigmented or natural.

The softening crème is not only a unique blend of chemicals to soften leather new and old it will also provide a waterproof protection to motorcycle leathers when applied and buffed up.

The Leather Softening Crème works by penetrating the leather to soak into every single fibre of the leather creating a soft supple leather again. If you're restoring old leather that has cracked what normally happens is the surface colourant cracks with it and this must be removed to restore your leather item back to new.

The Leather Softening Crème is designed to be used on old dried out leather, suitable for car seats, sofas, shoes, luggage and garments. It will also bring back some of the colour with its natural oils and preservative.

Where leather has become hard, brittle and dried out, stripped of its natural oils use the Leather Softening Crème to bring life back into the leather giving it that soft, supple, beautiful feel again.

1: The first stage is to deep clean the leather surface. This will help in the softening process of the leather. For the Leather Softening Crème to work, you need to make sure the leather is fully deep cleaned, free of dirt, grease, grime, silicones and waxes. It may be worth lightly vacuuming off the leather to remove small particles of dirt, but this is best done before any cleaning process is started. You're advised to use the LRC1 Leather Cleaner on pigmented leather, LRC7 Aniline Cleaner on aniline leather, LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner on nappa leather for professional results.

2: Leather Repair Company produces an outstanding Softening Crème with natural oils. The purpose of this is to aid in the restoration process of old worn dried out and cracked leather. The leather surface would be prepped if you are carrying out a colour restoration, the surface leather paint would be partially removed to allow the leather skin to be absorbent. This can be used as a standalone product if you wish without the need to carry out a restoration process as it's designed with a professional result in mind to soften old and dry leather and can be used just to do that without any further restoration required.

3: You can either apply the Softening Crème to a sponge, allow this to be massaged in or apply directly to the leather and massage in with your hands to ensure it perfectly penetrates every single time. A luxury massage roller can be used to improve the softening of dried, worn, old leather. During this process it's very important that you massage this Leather Softening Crème in as much as possible moving / flexing the leather to ensure it gets deep down into the dried-out leather pores and cracks. This will give a professional result every time making sure it's covered perfectly.

4: If you wanted, for serious cracking on extremely rare objects you can apply an additional generous coating of the Softening Crème and allow this to sit on the surface to penetrate over a period of time. Where the leather is extremely dry, it's best to massage in by hand, then fully wrap your leather in cling film or shrink wrap, this can be left for a few days to soak into the leather skin. Once removed apply an additional liberal coating and wrap once again, keep repeating this process until the leather is soft and supple again.

5: Once you're happy that the leather has been softened sufficiently and if you are not restoring the leather and the leather paint has not been removed, you can use a damp cloth with leather cleaner and wipe over the surface. If you don't want to remove any products to carry out a restoration process then you can just simply apply the Leather Protection Cream over the top of this, softening the leather even further with this process. If you are restoring the leather, wipe with a damp cloth with alcohol cleaner on to remove any excess softening crème that's not soaked into the leather hide, then you can start your restoration process.
