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LRC26 - Leather Glue

The leather glue is designed to glue back down tears and rips in leather and to glue in place sub patches to carry out repairs using heavy filler, flexi filler or quick dry filler.

The leather glue is a water-based formula and is safe to use on all types of leather, including aniline, suede and nubuck.

With aniline leather, suede and nubuck leather you just must be careful not to over apply the glue, so it doesn't get on the top fibres causing the top outside surface of the leather to go stiff when the glue sets. So, it's best to apply small amounts as you don't want the glue oozing out when you join the tear together like you would on a painted leather.

With all types of other leathers, not vinyl or plastics, the water-based leather glue produces a strong bond to repair tears and holes in leather.

The leather glue can be cleaned away with warm water when you have excess on the surface of the leather skin, this must be cleaned away prior to the glue fully setting.

Being safe to use and water-based this glue can be dried using a hair drier which speeds up the waiting times.

On pigmented / painted leathers the leather glue can be used to glue down small loose areas where the surface has lifted slightly like on scrapes and scuffs on the leather surface.

The glue can only be used to glue the rough side of the leather to the rough side of leather or the suede of leather to our backing fabric, this glue isn't strong enough to glue two painted areas together. A solvent-based glue is better for this process.

With this being a water-based glue and not a contact adhesive this allows you the time required to manoeuvre your sub patch into place or to secure your tear or hole, the glue begins to naturally cure within 20 minutes if left to set but sped up with a hair drier this can cure in as little as 5 minutes.

When cured this leather glue produces an extremely strong bond, that's very flexible and stays feeling soft under the surface, allowing the repair to still feel natural and normal.

Any glue on the surface of leather that's a painted finish must be cleaned off prior to drying the glue. If not removed this can take a long time to remove once it's cured. So once the repair is done remove any excess at once.

Do not get excess on the top side of aniline leather, suede leather or nubuck leather

Drying Time, around 5 minutes depending how thickly applied with a hair dryer.

Formula, a water based thin liquid.

Skin Allergies, if you have skin allergies always wear gloves, wear goggles when applying.

Cautions, Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children, may cause skin irritation. Seek medical attention at once, do not induce vomiting. Avoid contact with eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing. Use a mask at all times using in a well-ventilated area.
