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LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner

To clean Nappa leather you need to use the LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner.

The LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner is a very effective cleaner that deep cleans into the grain removing all dirt and grime, it's a very delicate cleaner designed for softer leather with Nappa in particular in mind.

Spray the <u>LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner</u> onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion, This will lift all the dirt and grime away from the leathers surface.

If your leather is extremely dirty then you can use a Brucle Leather Cleaning Brush to agitate the dirt and grime lifting it from deep down in the grain, creating a beautiful luxurious finish. Then finish off with the bamboo cleaning pad.

Predominantly leather that has a sheen to it is generally dirty. The sheen is created due to grease and grime on the leather that becomes shiny, in a lot of cases leather has a semi-matt finish to it, but when it's gone shiny it's the dirt and grime creating the shine, causing further damage to your leather surface.

We have given below a guide to cleaning items such as <u>Nappa Leather</u> and <u>Semi Aniline Leather</u> with an aniline leather you require a cleaner specific for this type of leather <u>Aniline Leather</u>,

The first stage of cleaning is to lightly vacuum off your leather item with a soft brush attachment to remove all dirt and debris from the leather, this will avoid scratching the leather when the cleaning process starts.



Step 1 Vacuum off the debris – Leather Cleaning

The next stage is to use a phone microscope if you have one to assess any damage that may be on the leather where you have to proceed with caution.

To the naked eye, a great deal of damage on the leather surface cannot be seen unless you use a phone microscope to view this correctly. See the picture below of damage viewed via a microscope, that normally would not be seen.

Once you have passed this stage you can proceed to use the LRC2 Luxury Leather Cleaner, this can be sprayed directly onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion, lifting all dirt and grime away. If you don't have a bamboo cleaning pad then the leather cleaner can be sprayed directly onto the leather and you can work this into the grain with a <u>brucle leather cleaning brush</u>. The bamboo cleaning pads are the safest method to clean Nappa leather, but if you have let your leather get too dirty then the brucle brush will have to be used at some stage to get deep down into the grain, then finish off with the bamboo cleaning pad.

If the leather is particularly dirty, then you can spray directly on to the leather and agitate this with a Brucle Leather Cleaning brush to get deep down within the grains structure to lift all the dirt and grime away and then finish off with a natural bamboo cleaning pad. On fine leather like Nappa, just be careful you don't rub too hard with brushes, as a Nappa leather finish is not like standard pigmented leather finish, it's a more delicate finish like an aniline is.

Once you have cleaned the area you are working on and you have lifted all dirt away with a <u>natural bamboo towel</u> or soft terry towel, turning the terry towel to a clean side as you go. This will help to dry the surface leaving the leather feeling and looking fresh again.

These pictures show how clean leather can be cleaned using the correct products and methods of cleaning. (Please note bottle and labels have changed since these were taken.)

Once all the areas are fully cleaned, a protection layer must be applied to help prevent against stains and dirt build up in the future. There are several ways leather can be protected from a nourishing cream to a durable coating that still allows the leather to breathe correctly but provides up to 5 years of protection on the surface.
