LRC33 – Aniline Protector Spray

The Aniline Protector Spray is designed to be spray applied to all aniline leather surfaces to give the leather a protective layer to help stop stains and dirt building up.

Make sure the item being protected is fully cleaned and dry before the application of the aniline protector spray is carried out.

Spray an even coating on and rub into the surface with an application pad or terry towel. When applying the coating, spray at distance of between 6 to 9 inches away from the surface, you don't want to flood aniline surfaces. It's best to apply several coatings to ensure all areas are protected correctly. Once the first coating has been applied and dried, you can then apply a second coating to ensure maximum protection is gained.

As aniline is a much higher quality leather skin, and it's naturally easier to waterproof as the fibre structure is much tighter and this can be easily protected with just a couple of spray applications.

After application of the aniline protection spray it's best to lightly brush the surface to give a nice new protected look to your leather. This will make sure that, in areas where too much has been applied it's dry and does not bond fibres together.

With aniline leather being a very absorbent leather it's difficult to make them completely waterproof. With our aniline protector the purpose is to give you that window when something is spilled on your item, it allows you time to wipe away before the spill penetrates the surface coating fully. We advise to re coat every 3 months to keep that protection level at its best.

Once you have applied the aniline protector spray, we always apply a couple of coating of [leather protection cream LRC4](#) to make sure the surface has the best protection levels to avoid stains and spills marking the leather surface.

Do not over apply the aniline protection spray by making the surface very wet as this can cause staining to appear. Just lightly spray on the coating and allow to dry naturally, each coating should be applied in the same way, then LRC4 should be applied thereafter for the best protection possible.

Items such as King Ranch leather require even more care, this is the best product to protect the surface. Make sure the king ranch leather is fully cleaned and dry before the application is carried out. Spray evenly on the surface and allow to dry, apply a second or third coating as required and then apply a couple of coats of LRC4 protection cream to give that barrier against stains and grime attacking your King Ranch truck seats.

- A 250ml bottle will coat garments, shoes, and handbags two or three times.
- A 500ml bottle is enough to cover a two-seat sofa and a chair.
- A 1ltr bottle is enough to cover a three-seat sofa and two single chairs.
- A 5ltr bottle is recommended for extra large areas such as multiple corner sofas and bench seats.

Use a mask at all times using in a well-ventilated area.
