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## **LRC3 Alcohol Cleaner**

To sanitise leather prior to painting you need to use the LRC3 Alcohol Cleaner.

The LRC3 Alcohol Cleaner is a very effective cleaner that deep cleans the surface and removes all grease prior to applying paints.

Apply the <u>LRC3 Alcohol Cleaner</u> onto a clean terry towel cloth and wipe the entire surface so it is ready to be painted. If you are painting a bolster only wipe the sections next to it gently do not rub too hard as the alcohol cleaner will also take off colour if used to aggressively. This will lift all the dirt and grime away from the leather as it sanitises the surface ready for painting.

The purpose of using Alcohol Cleaner, after you have used leather prep on your seats to remove the surface colour ready for a recolour, is to remove any grease or grime left. It also removes fingerprint grease and sweat that could be on the surface as the leather is in a fragile state while there is no colour on the surface it can absorb quickly, so using gloves is always advised when you are taking the colour off the leather.

The Alcohol Cleaner is water miscible which allows you to add water to it so it's not as aggressive. You can also mix the Alcohol Cleaner with LRC1 Leather Cleaner to give you a very strong cleaner, but again proceed with caution as the Alcohol Cleaner can take off the surface colour.

The Alcohol Cleaner, if mixed with LRC1 Leather Cleaner will become an extremely strong cleaner, this needs to be used with care on leathers. With items like vinyl's or plastic trims this can be mixed at a strong ratio, you could mix 75% Alcohol Cleaner to 25% Leather Cleaner LRC1 to give a very strong cleaner to help with the removal of stubborn dirt and mouldy spots, **but don't use a solution this strong on genuine leather**.

If using as a leather cleaner, you can apply directly onto the surface and use a Brucle Leather Brush to gently clean the surface but be careful not to scrub too hard as the alcohol content will remove colour if used to aggressively.

Where you have lacquer/clearcoat peeling off the surface, the Alcohol Cleaner can be used to remove the balance of this rather than Leather Prep. Once you are happy with the results you would again give the surface a final wipe down prior to applying the new lacquer/clearcoat on the surface to seal over your leather again.

In this picture it shows leather that has been surface prepared ready to re colour and then the alcohol cleaner being used gently to give a final clean down to sanitise the surface ready for paint to be applied.



With leather such as two tones, antique and rub off, use sparingly and with caution as the painted coatings are very fine and even using a strong leather cleaner can remove the topcoat, so the alcohol cleaner will remove this easily.

**Before Use,** always check in a small hidden area before using to ensure no colour is released. Make sure the surface is free of debris and the leather has been vacuumed off first of all and is not wet before use.

Colour, clear liquid

Smell, alcohol sanitiser smell

Formula, solvent based, but water miscible.

Skin Allergies, if you have skin allergies always wear gloves.

**Cautions,** Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children, may cause skin irritation. Seek medical attention at once, do not induce vomiting. Avoid contact with eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing.

**Uses,** to be used on all types of leather (other than suede and nubuck), to de sanitise the surface ready for painting. Can also be used as a strong cleaner for leather with great caution, can be used to clean plastics/vinyl and hard plastic trim.

**Works on,** car interiors, furniture, handbags, leather jackets, shoes, motorcycle suits, equestrian, purses, vinyl's, pigmented, semi aniline, waxy pull-up, two tone, antique, aniline, rub-off, faux, vegan, bonded and by cast leathers.
