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## LRC46 – Grain Copier Compound

The grain copier filler compound is a thick paste repair filler that is cured with heating tools to leave a grain impression in leather, hard plastics, and vinyl.

The grain copier compound is designed to put the grain back in the leather by applying this compound place a grain matt over the top then Teflon paper and heat up to set and cure.

The base grain is best applied in thin layers heat cured with a heat iron cover the filler with a Teflon sheet this helps avoid damage to the leather as you heat cure the compound.

The main purpose of this product is to replace the final top layer in leather, vinyl, and hard plastics, it produces the grain again, this is applied with a pallet knife, never over apply thinking more is better, less is much better, a little amount goes a long way.

Apply a thin layer to the areas, do not over apply and leave ridges in the filler, make sure all the edges are fully smoothed out, so this doesn't leave an uneven finish around the edges, once you are happy with the filler's application, you place a graining matt on the filler, place over the top of the matt the Teflon paper and then gently heat to set and cure.

Never take off the grain matt while its curing, because you will never get it back in the same pace again, so if you need to check if its cured, carefully lift one corner only keeping your other hand firmly on the grain matt so it doesn't move, carefully lift up the one corner to see if its cured, you will tell if it hasn't as it will still be slightly yellow.

If it requires more time, simply let the matt back down and apply more heat for a couple more minutes

This product can only cure with heat, its suggested a medium heat is on the dial if you dial goes from low to high, the setting can be just above the medium heat setting, this way you cure the compound a little slower, but it gives the product enough time to bond to the surrounding areas, if you cure this with far too much heat it could crumble and you could damage the leather or plastic item.

When applying the product do not get excess on the items being repaired, keep this type of filler to the damaged areas only, if you get filler on other areas, remove this, and then clean down the areas with alcohol cleaner. The reason for this is if you have excess filler around the damaged section, it will grain this and create a ridge which will be hard to remove without starting to make repairs look plastic.

**Temperatures,** do not allow to freeze or go below 7 °C.

**Colour,** light yellow thick paste.

**Smell,** no specific scent or aroma

**Drying Time,** dried with heat from a heat iron, cures in around 1 minute

**Formula,** a thick paste for graining leather.

**Skin Allergies,** if you have skin allergies always wear gloves, wear goggles when applying.

**Cautions,** Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children, may cause skin irritation. Seek medical attention at once, do not induce vomiting. Avoid contact with eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing. Use a mask at all times using in a well-ventilated area.
