LRC7 Aniline Leather Cleaner

To clean Aniline leather, veg tanned leather or vachetta leather you need to use the LRC7 Aniline Leather Cleaner.

The LRC7 Aniline Leather Cleaner is a very effective cleaner that deep cleans into the grain of aniline leather removing all dirt and grime, it's a very delicate cleaner designed for softer leathers like aniline or veg tanned leathers.

Spray the LRC7 Aniline Leather Cleaner onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion, this will lift all the dirt and grime away from the leather's surface.

If your leather is extremely dirty then you can use a Bruclé Leather Cleaning Brush gently to agitate the dirt and grime, lifting it from deep down in the grain, creating a beautiful luxurious finish. Then finish off with the bamboo cleaning pad.

Predominantly leather that has a sheen to it is generally dirty, the sheen is created due to grease and grime on the leather that becomes shiny, in a lot of cases leather has a semi-matt finish to it, but when it's gone shiny it's the dirt and grime creating the shine, causing further damage to your leather surface.

We have given below a guide to cleaning items such as [Aniline Leathers](#), [Nappa Leather](#) and [Semi Aniline Leather](#).

The first stage of cleaning is to lightly vacuum off your leather item with a soft brush attachment to remove all dirt and debris from the leather, this will avoid scratching the leather when the cleaning process starts.

The next stage is to use a phone microscope if you have one to assess any damage that may be on the leather where you have to proceed with caution.

Once you have passed this stage you can proceed to use the LRC7 Aniline Leather Cleaner, this can be sprayed directly onto a bamboo cleaning pad and work into the leather in a circular motion, lifting all dirt and grime away. If you don't have a bamboo cleaning pad then the leather cleaner can be sprayed directly onto the leather and you can work this into the grain with a gentle motion with a [brucle leather cleaning brush](#).

The bamboo cleaning pads are the safest method to clean aniline leather or veg tanned leathers, but if you have let your leather get too dirty then the brucle brush will have to be used at some stage to get deep down into the grain, then finish off with the bamboo cleaning pad.

If the leather is particularly dirty, then you can spray directly on to the leather and gently agitate this with a Brucle Leather Cleaning brush to get deep down within the grains structure to lift all the dirt and grime away and then finish off with a natural bamboo cleaning pad. On fine leather like aniline or veg tanned just be careful you don't rub too hard with brushes as the leathers finish is not like standard pigmented leather finish, it's a more delicate finish and can easily be damaged rubbing too hard with a brush.

Once you have cleaned the area you are working on, lift all dirt away with a [natural bamboo towel](#) or soft terry towel, turning the terry towel to a clean side as you go. This will help to dry the surface leaving the leather feeling and looking fresh again. NEVER force dry your leather or put near sources of heat as this can cause staining which is difficult to remove.

Once all the areas are fully cleaned, a protection layer must be applied to help prevent against stains and dirt build up in the future. There are several ways leather can be protected from a nourishing cream to a durable coating that still allows the leather to breathe correctly but provides up to 5 years of protection on the surface.

Great for use on delicate items like two tone leathers, briefcases, handbags, wallets, purses etc.

Works on, car interiors, furniture, handbags, leather jackets, shoes, motorcycle suits, equestrian, purses, vinyl's, aniline, pigmented, semi aniline, waxy pull-up, two tone, antique, aniline, rub-off, faux, vegan, bonded and by cast leathers.
